Dr. Joseph Gnanadickam Memorial Oration Award for Dr. Ramakrishnan




Aravind, September 4-9

Lecture Series on Proteomics and Applications

Aravind – Madurai, August 3



A one day lecture series on Proteomics and applications was conducted by the Department of Proteomics, Aravind Medical Research Foundation.
